Policy

Supervision for Provisional Registrants

Provisional Members may select a supervisor who is a general member in good standing with the College of Counselling Therapy of Prince Edward Island. Provisional registrants are required to receive 1 hours of supervision for every 10 direct client contact hours. Supervision may be one on one, or in a supervision group. Supervision groups may not exceed a ratio of 1 supervisor to 6 supervisees.

Please note: Provisional supervision hours may not be claimed toward your continuing competency hours.

Supervision for Continuing Competency

General Members may select a supervisor who meets the following criteria:

A holder in good standing of one of the following designations:

Association of Cooperative Counselling Therapists of Canada – Registered Counselling Supervisor (RCS)

Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association – Canadian Certified Counsellor – Supervisor (CCC-S)

Canadian Professional Counselling Association – Master Practitioner in Clinical Counselling – Supervisor (MPCC-S)



Or all of the following:

- 1. Completion of a supervision training course approved by council (or equivalent training and experience approved by council)
- 2. Minimum of 5 years of practice
- 3. Good standing registration in a recognized counselling or related professional association whose members practice counselling therapy
- 4. Minimum of 1,000 hours of direct client contact and 100 hours of supervision post-graduation.

All supervisors and supervisees must complete a CCTPEI supervision contract.
